

FELINE LEUKEMIA FACTS

- 1. Feline Leukemia is a form of CANCER!**
It may affect the blood, internal organs, or form tumors.
- 2. Feline Leukemia is HIGHLY CONTAGIOUS from cat to cat.**
It may be spread by licking, sneezing, fighting, sharing food bowls, or sharing litter pans.
- 3. It is estimated that 30% of all stray cats are infected today.**
- 4. It is one of the MAJOR causes of death in cats today.**
- 5. It primarily affects the cat by DECREASING THE RESISTANCE of the cat to other disease.** It acts very similar to the AIDS VIRUS in humans.
- 6. Diagnosis is made by clinical signs and a blood test.**
- 7. There is NO SUCCESSFUL TREATMENT!**
- 8. The virus does NOT live outside the cat's body over 2-3 days.**
- 9. It is the CLOSEST RELATED VIRUS to the AIDS VIRUS of people known today!**
- 10. Due to the seriousness of this disease, we HIGHLY RECOMMEND THAT ALL CATS be vaccinated!** Once the disease is contracted there is NO cure!
- 11. Research evidence to date shows NO possibility that Feline Leukemia is transmissible to humans.**
